MR. THOMAS CHARLES, one of the oldest fruit-growers of Goulburn, died on Sunday morning last at the age of 82 years. Deceased had been ailing for some time prior to his death, being confined to his room for upwards of 18 months. He was a native of Nottingham, England, and came almost direct to Goulburn, having been a resident here for nearly half-a-century. He was very successful as a fruit-grower, and his sons, Messrs. H. C., J. T., and R. H. Charles, are amongst our leading orchardists and horticulturists. He leaves four sons and two daughters, one of his sons being in the railway service, and residing at Young. For the last few years he had resided with his son, Mr. R. H. Charles.
