

DEATH OF MRS. S. PERRETT.

THAN passed away at Flinders, about mid-day on Friday last, a very old and respected resident of the district in the person of Mrs. Perrett, relict of the late Mr. Sealy Perrett, who predeceased his wife by about three years. Death was due to a general break-up of the system consequent upon old age. The deceased had attained the ripe age of 79 years, and had resided in the Flinders district for the last 33 years. She came to Australia 49 years ago, and, on arrival, took up her residence in Ipswich, where she remained for some years, subsequently removing to Flinders. She leaves one daughter—Mrs. C. Walton, of Rosevale,—and two sons—Messrs. Harry and William Perrett, both of the Flinders district—to mourn their loss and much sympathy has been expressed for them in their bereavement. The funeral took place on Sunday afternoon and was largely attended.
