

ANNUAL LICENSING DAY.

THE Annual Meeting for the granting of Publican's Licenses, was held at the Court-house, Braidwood, yesterday. There were not sufficient Magistrates present at noon to transact the business of the meeting, and the Court adjourned for an hour, when the following Justices were in attendance:—J. W. Bunn, Josh. Taylor, W. J. Bennison, and J. McKellar, Esquires.

The applicants and sureties being in attendance, the following applications were granted with the exception of B. Bogan, who it was stated, had abandoned his house since the forwarding of the application, and had no intention of pressing it.

In the matter of the application of Josiah Taylor, for a license for the Bridge Inn, at Long Swamp, it was stated by Mr. Gurney that he had placed it upon the list, although no application had been forwarded according to the requirements of the law. Mr. Taylor appeared, however, with his sureties, but the Bench told him that they could not move in the matter,—that his only course would be to take steps to obtain authority to open the house from the Bench in Petty Sessions.

Mr. Hogg submitted to the Bench a letter, dated 9th ultimo, from the Chief Constable of Queanbeyan, which contained a statement to the effect that the house was not in his opinion well conducted, and that he was never at home.

This Mr. Taylor denied, and his case therefore stands over until he can take further action in the matter.

We regret exceedingly that such should be the case, for Mr. Taylor's house, in our opinion was one of the best conducted, and he is as much respected as any one, in the district.
