

PUBLICANS' LICENSES.

YESTERDAY was the Annual Meeting of Justices for consideration of applications for certificates for publicans' licenses in and for the District of Braidwood, but up to one o'clock, the limit allowed by the law as it at present stands, there were only two magistrates present, J. W. Bunn and J. Taylor, Esquires, who were consequently compelled to adjourn the Court until Thursday next, (to morrow).

The following applications had been duly lodged with the Clerk of Petty Sessions, and excepting in one instance, all the parties and their sureties, amounting in all to upwards of 100 people, were punctually in attendance. The adjournment until Thursday has compelled many of these parties, some of whom have rode a distance of 30 miles to sustain their applications, to remain in town at considerable expense as well as personal inconvenience to themselves, rather than run the risk of being detained by the floods which were likely to set in, in consequence of the intermittent fall of rain which prevailed throughout the day.
